Reflection Questions

- What are your favorite holidays? What is it about those particular holidays that you appreciate and enjoy?
- When you consider Christmas, what words, thoughts and feelings come to mind? Why?
- When you think about Jesus, do you think of Him more as "divine" (i.e. God) or "human" (i.e. a person)? Why? In what ways have you neglected the other aspect of who Jesus is? How does knowing how Christians have wrestled through this mystery in the past help you to better understand and know Jesus?
- How does knowing that Jesus was fully human encourage and comfort you? How does knowing Jesus is fully God encourage and comfort you?
- Why is it important to keep the cross (i.e. Good Friday/Easter) in mind as celebrate Christmas?
- Have you -- and do you -- confess Jesus as Lord? If not, what's preventing you? What are some next steps you can take?
- As you consider the humility (and selflessness) of Jesus, what are some ways you can grow in humility (and selflessness) in your relationships and interactions with others?
